



Literary Societies

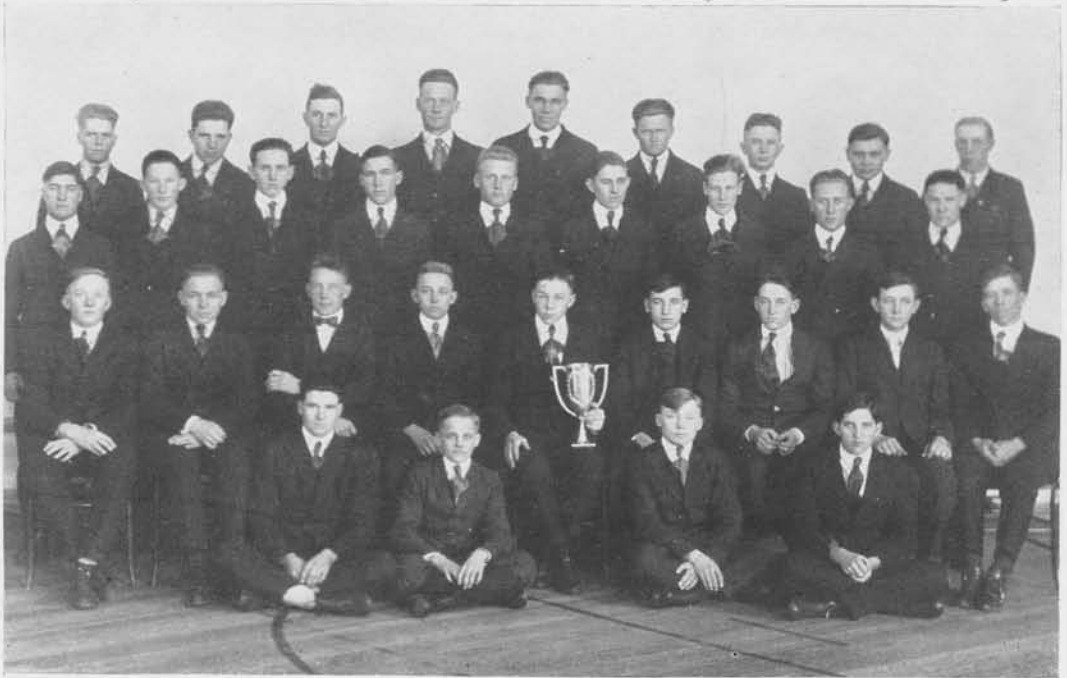
