



The Soldiers and Sailors Memorial

Through the untiring efforts of our superintendent in concurrence with the Alumni Association, on Home Coming Day, a splendid idea has been put in operation.

A memorial for the Northwest School boys who gave their lives in the great struggle was proposed at that time. The intention is that this shall be symbolic of the respect felt towards those who made the supreme sacrifice, and to recognize in a suitable way the services of all those whose names appeared on the honor roll.

The proposed location of this memorial is near the southwest entrance to the campus. It is hoped that the road now leading in to the campus from the bridge may be removed and two parallel roads be built in its place. The memorial will be located between these two roads, about forty feet east of the windbreak that runs back of Kiehle and Robertson buildings.

When this project was first considered, the cost was put at a minimum of \$2500, but the response already made by the student body alone shows that such a small amount will not be considered.

Mr. Selvig once expressed a wish that it should be built of marble. We always try to come up to your wishes, Mr. Selvig, and we hope that we can help this wish of yours to be realized.
