



## Junior Extension Work



Although Boys' and Girls' Club Work has been carried on in the Red River Valley for the past two or three years, it has not been given the attention and support that there will be the coming year. One of the Assistant State Club Leaders is now stationed at the

Northwest School of Agriculture and will devote his entire time to helping club leaders, county agents, county superintendents, and others to promote the work in the territory covered by the Northwest School.

For the coming year, a great deal of emphasis will be put on livestock work. Every county is taking up one or more of the livestock projects, namely, Baby Beef, Dairy Calf, Sheep, or Pig. The other state projects are also being taken up in many localities. The Bread Making, Garment Making, Gardening, Canning, and Poultry projects are attracting boys and girls who live in town. The Potato project is one that is taken up by every county.

Plans are being made to hold a Junior Live Stock Show in Crookston next November, the week preceding the State Junior Live Stock Show. This promises to be one of the big events of the year in the Red River Valley.
