FARM MECHANICS

THIS is a course taught in a practical manner, dealing with the mechanics on the farm. The following subjects are included in the course: rope work, splicing, tying knots, whipping; bearing, pouring and scraping; pipe fitting, drawing simple water system for farm and making model of it; belt lacing; soldering and tin work, making funnels, dust pans, and other equipment.

ELEMENTARY MOTORS

This is a general course given with a view of getting students familiar with the names of all parts of tractors and automobiles. The proper care and operation is also taught as well as the function of each unit. It is a preparatory course for advanced motors.
