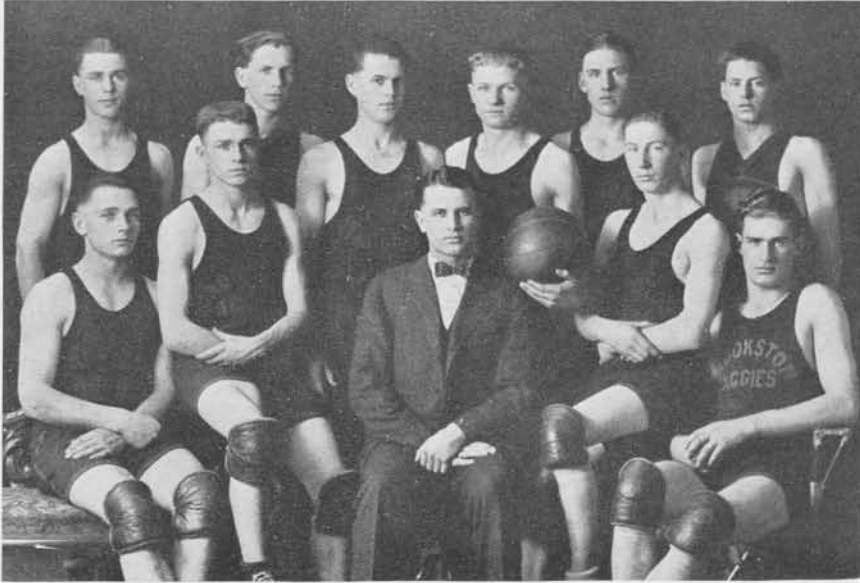


## Basket Ball
