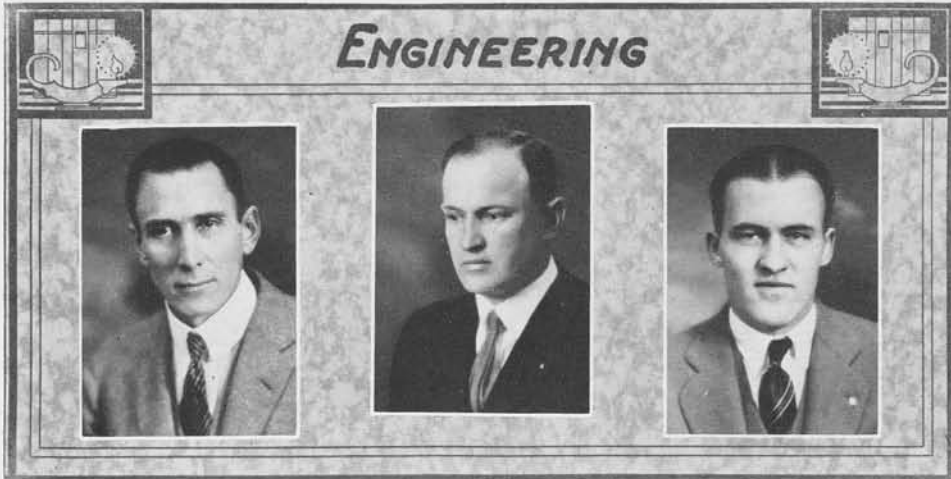


FACULTY
