THE Young Men's Christian Association was founded in London in 1844, by George Williams. The Young Women's Christian Association was founded in London in 1855 to open a home for nurses returned from the Crimean War, and for young business women. Both organizations were established for the purpose of the promotion of the social, physical, intellectual, and spiritual welfare of young men and women.

The Y. M. and the Y. W. C. A. at the Northwest School have been playing a very active part in the activities of the school for many years. Some of the activities sponsored by these organizations are the "Boys' Pow Wow," the "Girls' Frolic," and the Saturday evening reception, which are held during the first week of each fall term. Every Sunday morning an hour is spent in Bible study, which is conducted by the various members of the faculty. The Sunday evening sessions consist of student programs, and sermons given by pastors of the different churches of Crookston.
