

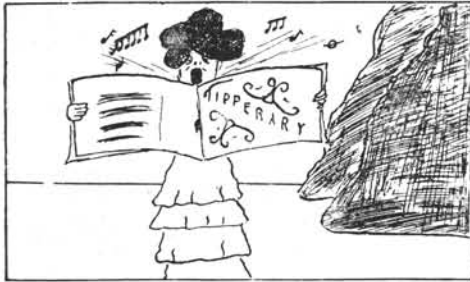
November 27-December 2;
