## Y. W. C. A. and Y. M. C. A. Organizations

The Christian Association at the Northwest School is a voluntary organization of students and faculty. It has as its purpose, development and growth in religion parallel with and equal to growth in intellect and body. Every Sunday morning an hour is spent in Bible Study, which is conducted by various members of the faculty. Religious exercises are held in the school auditorium each Sunday evening. These consist of student programs and sermons given by pastors of the various churches of Crookston. These sessions are put on in mutual cooperation of the Y. W. C. A. and the Y. M. C. A.
