CROOKSTON AGGIES, 0—MORRIS AGGIES, 19

Scoring one touchdown which was called back because of holding in the first few minutes of the first quarter, the Crookston Aggies went down to defeat before the North Central School at Morris in their third encounter of the season. Radniecki, Crookston half-back, took the ball on his own 40-yard line and raced 60 yards for a touchdown, but the referee called it back because a teammate had held and the score at the quarter was 0-0.

The Crookston Aggies came back strong in the second half but after losing the ball on downs on their own 25-yard line, were routed by a series of line plays and their opponents pushed the sphere across the line for their second counter. In the third stanza the Morris Aggies plunged over the goal line for the third marker after another peculiar pass brought the ball to the Crookston three-yard line. The Crookston team completed several passes near the end of the game and had the ball on their opponents 20-yard line when the gun sounded the end of the tilt.
