Caleb Dorr Progress Recognition

By a decision made in April, 1922, by the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota, a part of the Dorr fund was made available to the schools of agriculture. This fund consisted of \$50,000 willed by the late Caleb Dorr, of Minneapolis, the income of which was to be used to promote scholarship and student activity records.
