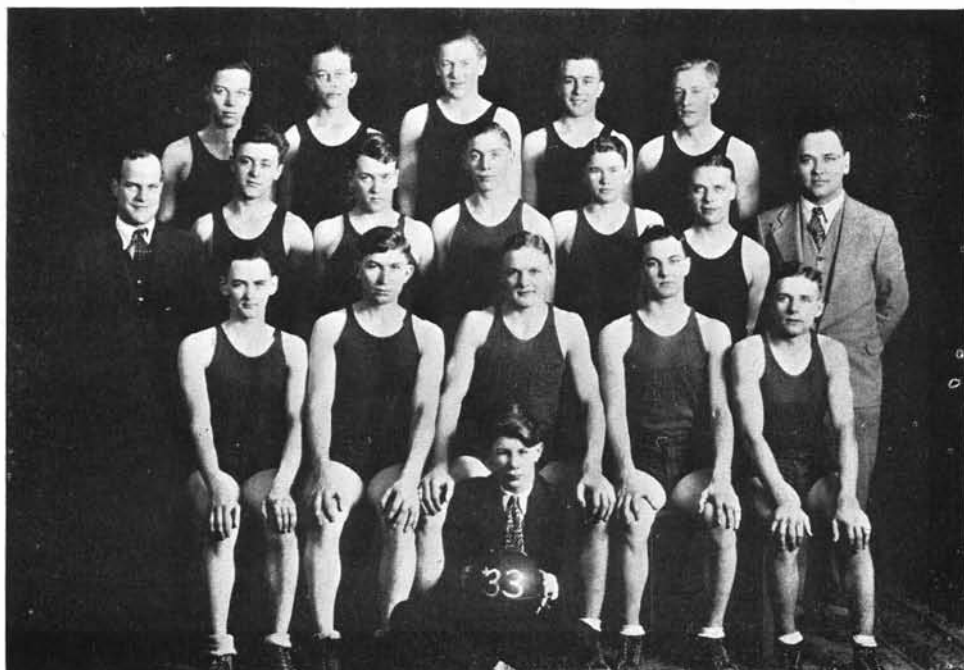


## Red River Aggie

## BASKETBALL
