Weather records have been kept by the Agronomy department since its organization. Since 1910 these records have included maximum and minimum temperatures, precipitation, direction of wind and character of day. Before 1910 records at the Station were less complete. The equipment has always been of standard weather bureau type and the records have been accepted as official. In 1915 the Station was made a cooperative station of

the Weather Bureau and in 1922 it became a Corn and Wheat region station reporting by telegraph during the crop season.

The work of the Agronomy department at the Northwest Experiment Station is closely co-ordinated with that of the central station and other branch stations. Investigations of regional problems have frequently originated at the local Station but achievements are cooperative.
