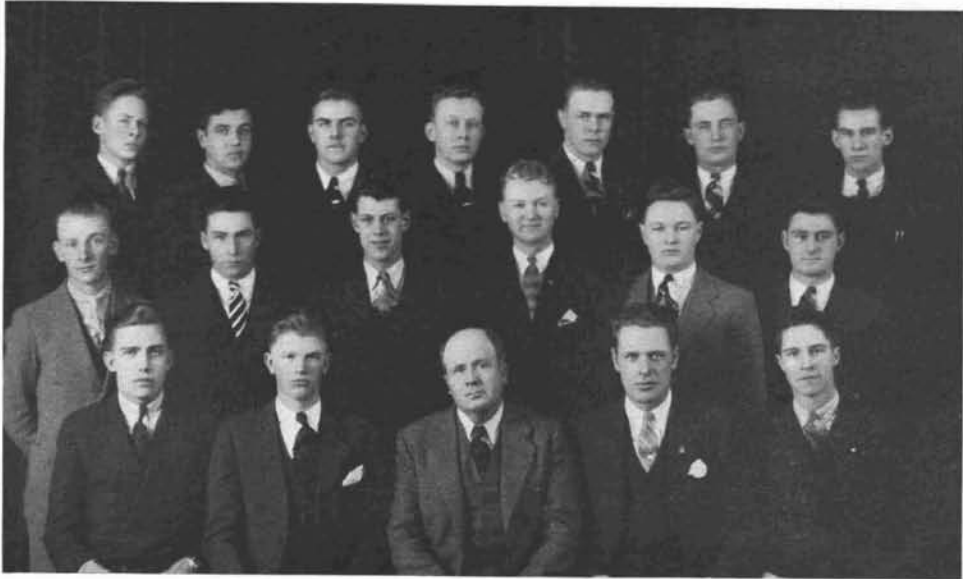


"A" Club
