Coulter—has been captain of the Cross Country team for three years. He has won two wings and an “A”. “Scotchy” was a true track man and a natural captain.

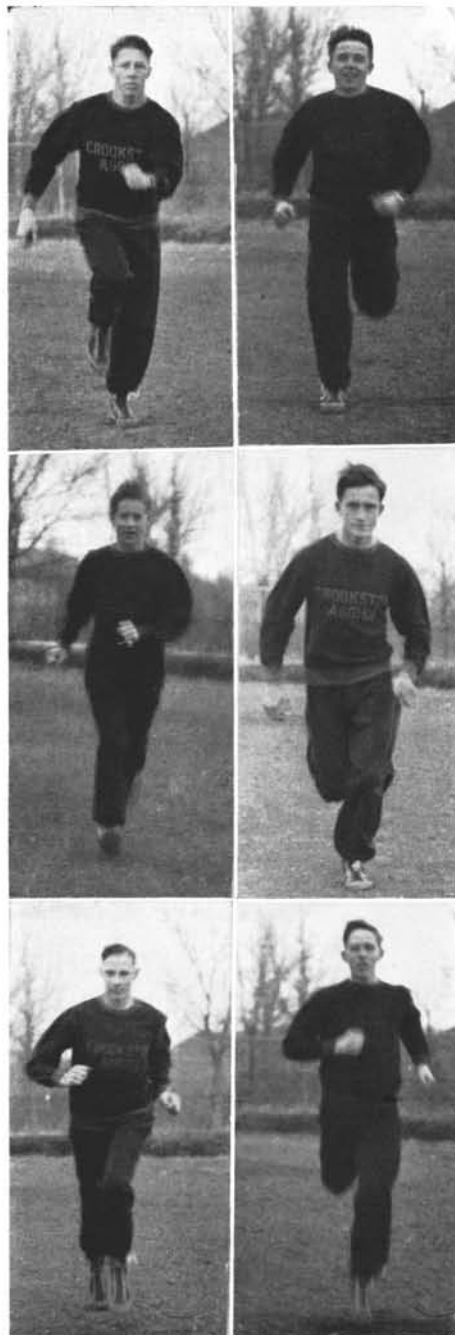
