


CHAMPIONS

October 25. Aggies Win Opening Conference Tilt. It was, indeed, an enthusiastic bunch of "Pigskin Carriers" who opened their first conference game on Homecoming Day. The game opened with Grand Rapids' kicking-off to Crookston. "Lefty" Loyd got away for the first touchdown. Throughout the game the Crookston boys had things pretty much to themselves. In the last half of the game the ball was kept pretty well on the opponent's territory. With a pass from Beucler to Loyd the game ended in a 18-0 victory for Crookston.

November 3. Many Parents See First Football Game. Parents and students turned out in large numbers to watch one of the main attractions of Parents' Day—a football game played between the Aggies and the Concordia frosh. While the Aggies were showing improvement, they were shoved back repeatedly by the more experienced and heavier college team.
