The Young Men's and Young Women's Christian Association under the supervision of Mr. Kiser, Miss Bede, Miss Kingston, Miss Noyes, Mr. McCall, and Mr. Pilkey carries out the religious educational program for the students of the Northwest School. This organization provides Sunday morning and evening programs throughout the school year. The girls meet each Sunday morning in Robertson Hall and the boys in Stephens. The student officers preside at these meetings and short talks are given by members of the faculty, and all participate in song and prayer. At the Sunday evening meetings the choir is present to lead in the singing. Ministers from the churches of Crookston are generous in offering their services as speakers at these meetings.
