## LIVESTOCK JUDGING

The livestock judging squad meets three times a week in the judging pavillion under the direction of Mr. Kiser. The object of the course is to teach future farmers how to recognize and select good livestock. After the boys have had several months of practice, Mr. Kiser picks out three men to represent the school at the sub-collegiate contest which is held annually during Winter Shows week. This year Northwest School competed with North Central School of Agriculture, West Central School of Agriculture, Central (St. Paul) School of Agriculture, South Dakota School of Agriculture, and Walsh County School of Agriculture. North Central took first place with 2218 points, our team placed second with 2106 points, and West Central placed with 2027 points.
