## COMMENCEMENT

The thirty-fourth annual commencement exercises of the Northwest School of Agriculture were held in the school auditorium on March 26, 1942. Superintendent McCall presided at the exercises which opened with a musical selection presented by the school band and orchestra. The invocation was given by the Reverend Harold Peterson of Crookston. Miss Irene Olson of Halstad, Senior class president, then presented the class address in which she paid tribute to both parents and faculty for their assistance and encouragement. The Commencement address was given by Mr. Theodore Fenske, Superintendent of the West Central School and Station. He used as his theme "Coming of Age in a World Crisis".

After giving awards for Scholarship and extra-curricular activity, Superintendent McCall presented diplomas to three and four year students. The exercises were closed with the singing of "Minnesota Hail To Thee" by the entire school.
