Under the able direction and supervision of the officers and with the aid of the faculty advisers, the Young Women's and Young Men's Christian Association not only carries out the religious educational program for the students at the Northwest School but plans and supervises many social events as well.

At the beginning of the fall term the YW sponsored a mixer for the girls—the Girls' Frolic, and the YM directed the boys' mixed—the Boys' Pow-Wow. The first Saturday evening, October 9, the two organizations together entertained at an All-School Reception for both the new students and the new faculty members.

Sunday morning meetings formerly were held for girls in the parlor of Robertson Hall, while the meeting for the boys was held in Stephens Hall Assembly. This year, however, joint meetings of the boys and girls are being held alternately in each of the dormitories. At these meetings, at which student officers preside, the Y members carry on informal discussions or listen to short talks by different members of the faculty.

Every Sunday evening services are held for both the boys and girls in the auditorium. The ministers from Crookston churches, as well as other speakers from off campus, deliver the messages at the Vespers. Music supplied by the Advanced Choir adds to the spiritual warmth of these occasions. At the close of the Sunday evening devotions, educational films are shown.
