Mr. T. M. McCall has the responsibility of administrating the Northwest School and Experiment Station. Although our school term is only six months long, the station provides an important full-time job for our capable superintendent. The evaluation of the property Mr. McCall superintends is: 915.89 acres and 36 buildings, the total value of which is \$1,318,-945.14. This figure does not include the value of equipment or animals raised by the station. The buildings listed include 13 school buildings (classroom buildings, dormitories, physical education building, dining hall, administration building, health service building, heating plant, and greenhouse), and 23 residences and farm buildings.

The Northwest School and Experiment Station is a high school branch of the University of Minnesota's School of Agriculture and, as such, is an institution of the state. The state of Minnesota and Mr. McCall are doing an excellent job of bringing improved farming methods to the young and old of the Midwest.
