

JUDGING TEAMS

The judging teams at the Northwest School help the boys to learn to judge the quality of their livestock, grain crops, and potatoes. Potato Judging is directed by Mr. Beresford who guides and instructs the boys in the identification of the many varieties of potatoes and their diseases. Dr. Soine coaches the Crops Judging Team. His instructions in recognizing weeds, grass and legume seed, as well as plant diseases, are very helpful to the boys registered in this activity.

Livestock Judging, under the able direction of Mr. Stolen, teaches the boys to judge sheep, dairy and beef cattle, and swine. Each team is formed by three boys and an alternate who compete with the other station schools at the Red River Valley Winter Shows in Crookston.
