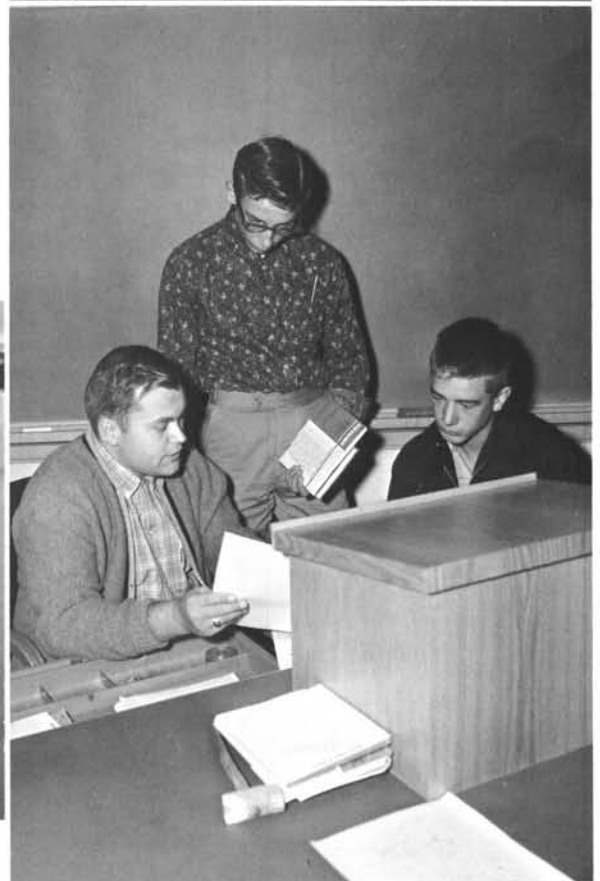
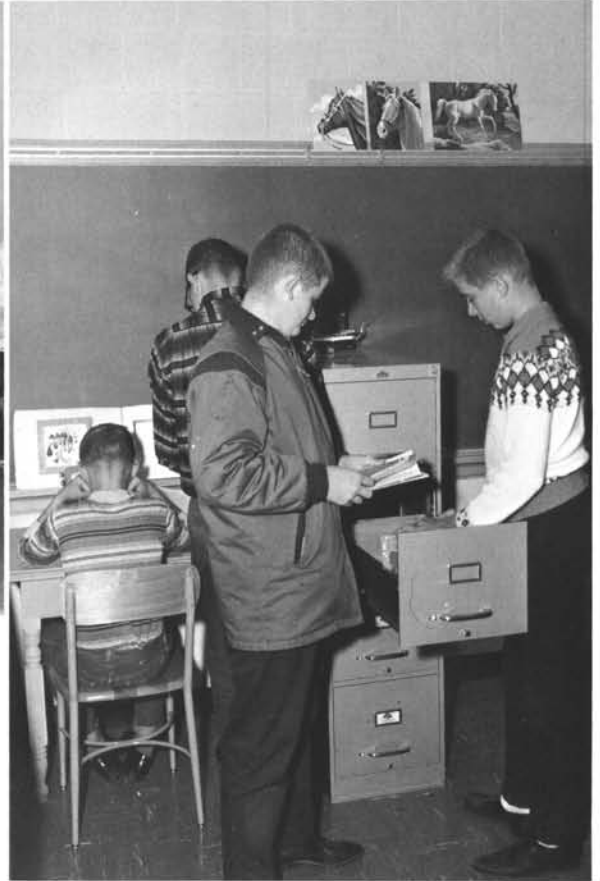


Reading Skills

To eliminate bad reading habits, good ones are taught by increasing speed, enlarging vocabulary and working toward the improvement of comprehension through the special periods that are set aside each morning for speed drills, reading orally and practice with words sounds. Before students can begin these courses, however, they are given an Audio-Visual test. Next they are given the Iowa silent reading test to determine their present reading rate and comprehension. Later on during the course, they will be given several other Iowa tests to determine further progress.
