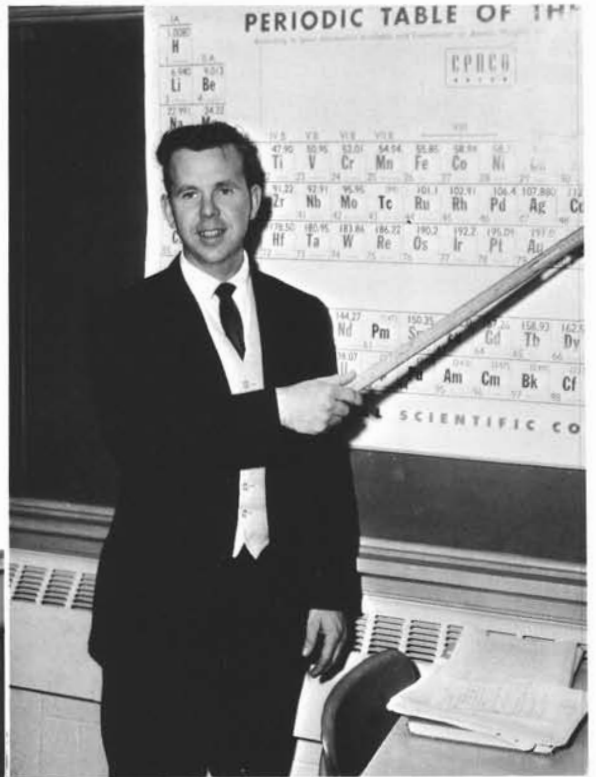


Science
