



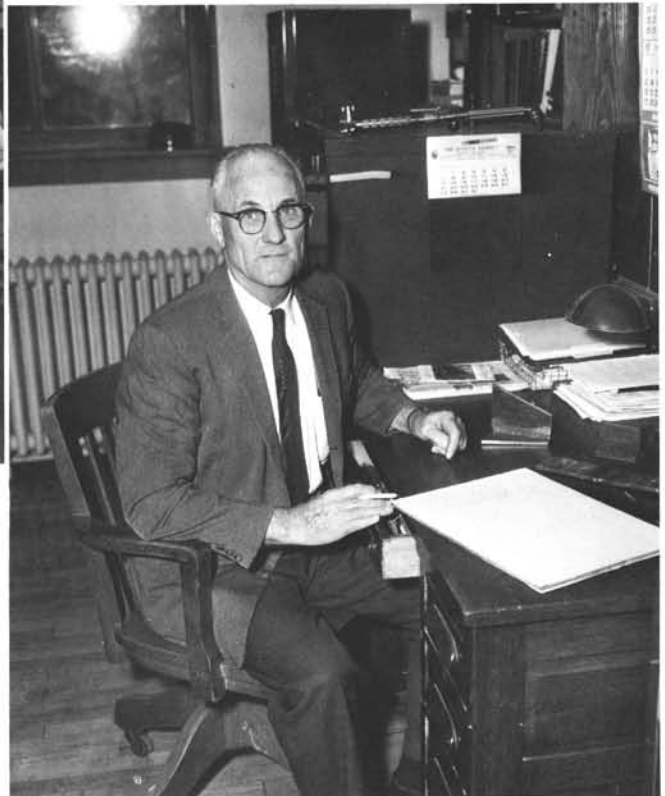

Gas Welding

Have you ever seen the flashing light streaming forth from the windows of Mr. Soderburg's room in Owen Hall? If you have, you probably know that it comes from the welding classroom.

In gas welding there are two main gases used, oxygen and acetylene. In the shop we begin welding pieces of metal together without any welding rod. Next, heavier metal is welded together with welding rods. In another project, larger rods about three-fourths of an inch are welded together.
