

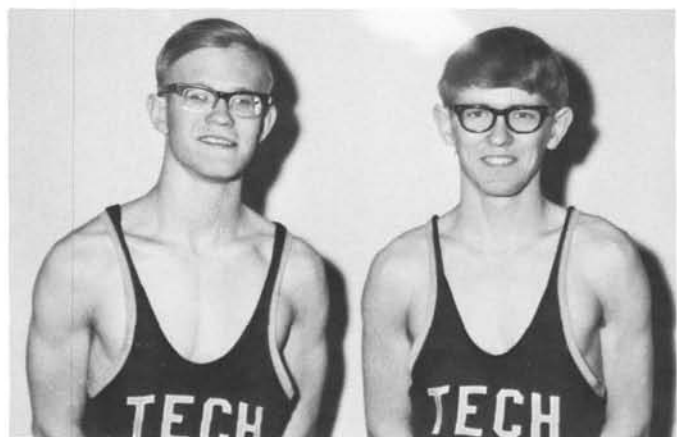

Minnesota Tech wrestlers had a good season this year with a four win and four loss record, the 1966-1967 wrestling team consisted of several inexperienced members who finished the season with commendable records. The Trojans attended a tri-angular meet at Bottineau, North Dakota. Placing first was Minnesota Tech with 52, followed closely by Minot State J. V. with 50 and Bottineau with 17. The Trojans won second in the northern Junior college wrestling conference. Two wrestlers won first place in this conference. Tech's athletic director Hershel Lysaker and Coach Rodney Mosher accompanied these two winners to the national Junior College wrestling tournaments at Worthington, Minnesota. The winners were Keith Johnson at 123 lbs. and Richard Kaltenberg at 130 lbs.. Both of these wrestlers ended up with seventh place berth at his tournament.
