November, 1967, marked the formation of a placement bureau at the University of Minnesota Technical Institute. Under the direction of Ronald Ebner, the department has as its responsibility and objective providing service to students, faculty, and employers seeking qualified Tech students.

Here graduates receive counsel for seeking and gaining career employment. They prepare and compile occupational resués to assist them with the employment search. Employer job descriptions and brochures are filed and displayed with other labor market information. A central facility for employer contact and on-campus interviewing provides the job-seeking student with on-the-spot first-hand information.
