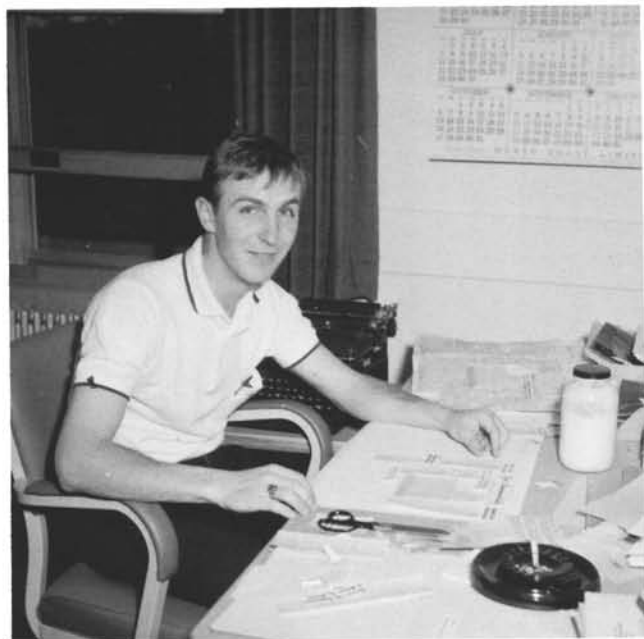


Brains and Pains Produce Commentator
