



Cold Spring Temps

Minnesota Tech won its first track meet of the season on April 5 by dumping Northland, 69-31. The Trojans captured ten first places out of the 12.

Fergus Falls captured first in the eleven events to down the Trojans on April 12.

The team traveled to the Virginia Invitational April 29. Mesabi men took first, defeating Tech and four other colleges. Mesabi squeaked by with a mere half point. The Vikings scored 48, beating Fergus' 47 1/2 points, and Tech's 37. Other schools placing were Hibbing, 26; Itasca, 20; and Northland, 10. In the 70-yd. dash Eickhoff won Tech's only first place. Lysaker gathered an individual second place in the 70-yd. high and low hurdles.

Minnesota Tech placed second in a triangular with Wahpeton and Northland. Gustafson placed second in the 220-yd. dash in the Northern State Conference on May 22, while Baston took third in the low hurdles. Gilger was fifth in the mile.
