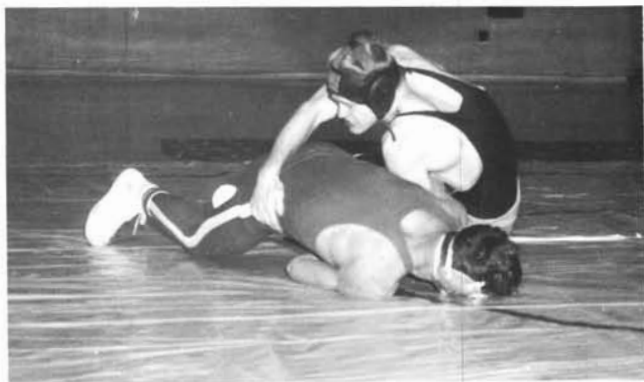


# Mosher Strongmen Have Good Season

Under the direction of Coach Rodney Mosher, who helped the team through some tight spots, the wrestling team ended its season with a 2-4 conference record. Tech wrestlers lost their first match, 21-14, to the UND freshmen. Later the Trojans entered an invitational tourney at UND, taking second among four teams. Jan 6 Tech hosted Metropolitan College of Minneapolis, Metro squeezing ahead of Tech with a 19-14 win. The first conference win for the Trojans came on Jan 15 when Tech wiped Northland, 30-3. A unique match with United College of the University of Manitoba in January followed free style rules. The Trojans picked off Winnipeg, 17-13.

Feb. 10 the grapplers traveled to Mayville to a quadrangular meet where Tech placed third. The locals placed second in the Northern Junior College Conference at Grand Rapids. Tech took four men to the National Junior College Wrestling meet. They were Keith Johnson, 123 lbs.; Richard Kaltenberg, 130 lbs.; and wrestling co-captains, Peter Novotny, 160 lbs. and Steve Simones, 167 lbs.
