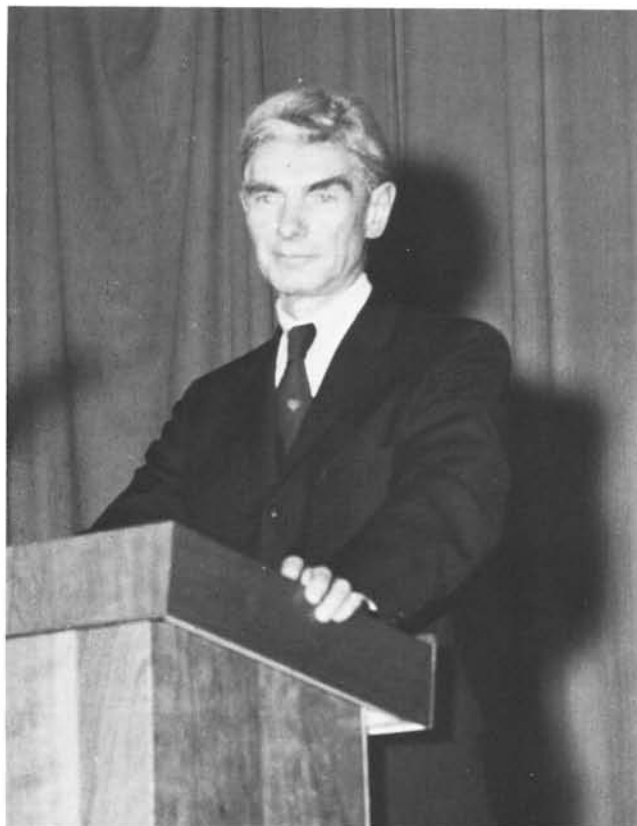


Feb. 28 ceremony honors law chief

To honor Oscar R. Knutson, chief justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court, the college dedicated the gymnasium February 28 as Knutson Hall. The impressive ceremonies were attended by officials from the Twin cities campus and by state and local dignitaries and friends of this outstanding alumnus of the former Northwest School and the University of Minnesota. Men and women students furnished music and four veterans took charge of the flag presentation and pledge. After the dedicatory ceremonies a public reception was held in the college dining room. The plaque has been placed inside the gymnasium at the east entrance to the building. Participating in the program were Pres. Malcolm Moos, Vice Pres. Donald Smith, Dean Sherwood Berg of the Institute of Agriculture, Dr. S. D. Sahlstrom, director at UMC, and Dr. B. E. Youngquist at the Northwest Experiment Station.
