

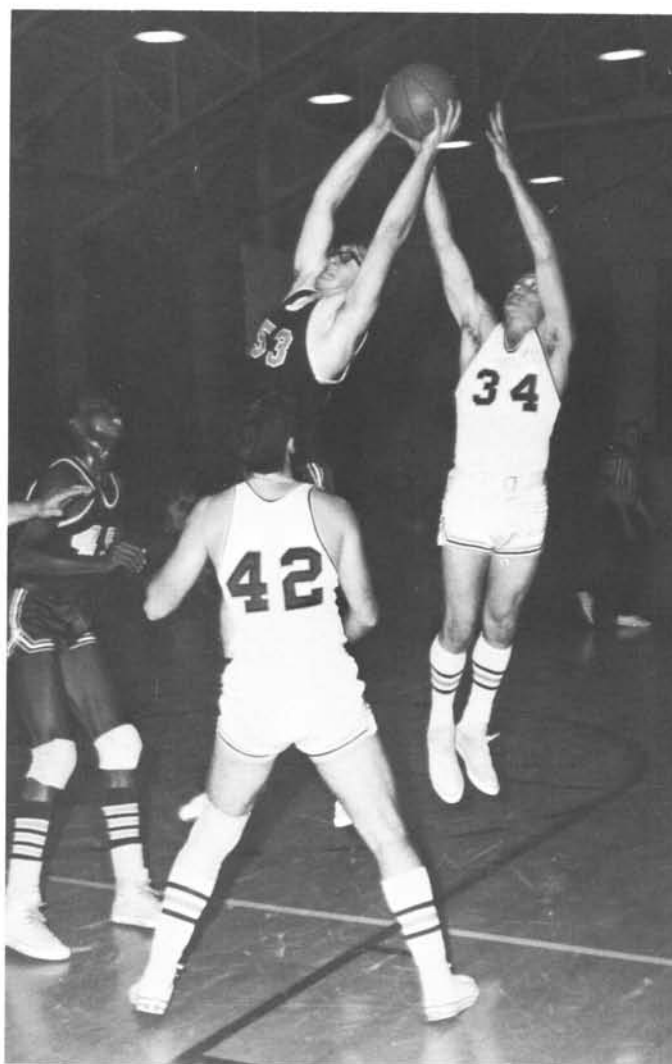
Bachmeier's men Top conference

Led by all-conference players Brian Sjodin and Lloyd Mayes, the UMC basketball squad fought its way to the top of the conference. The title was clinched in what was perhaps the best team effort of the season, a 106-71 win over Fergus Falls.

The turning point of the season was the victory over Mesabi Junior College at Virginia. At this time Tech realized their strength and went on to win eight of their last eleven games. The team finished with a 46.6% field goal average, and they hit 63.7% of their free throws. Leading scorer for the year was Lloyd Mayes, who totaled 517 points for an average of 22.4 per game. Mayes also led in rebounds, with 338, for an average of 14.7 per game.
