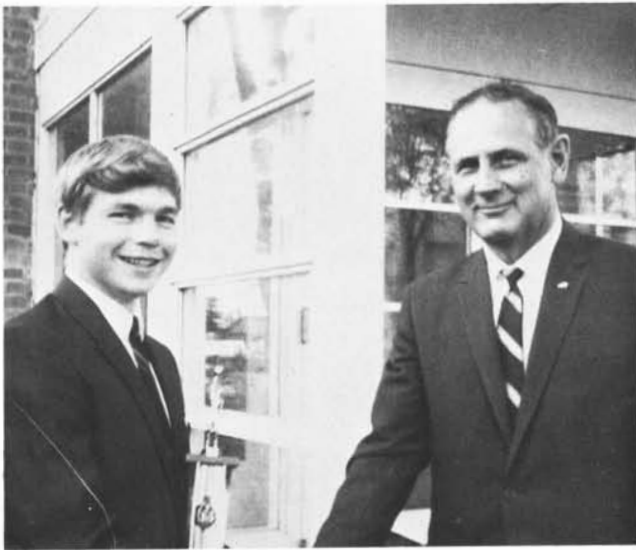


Introducing several athletic winners
