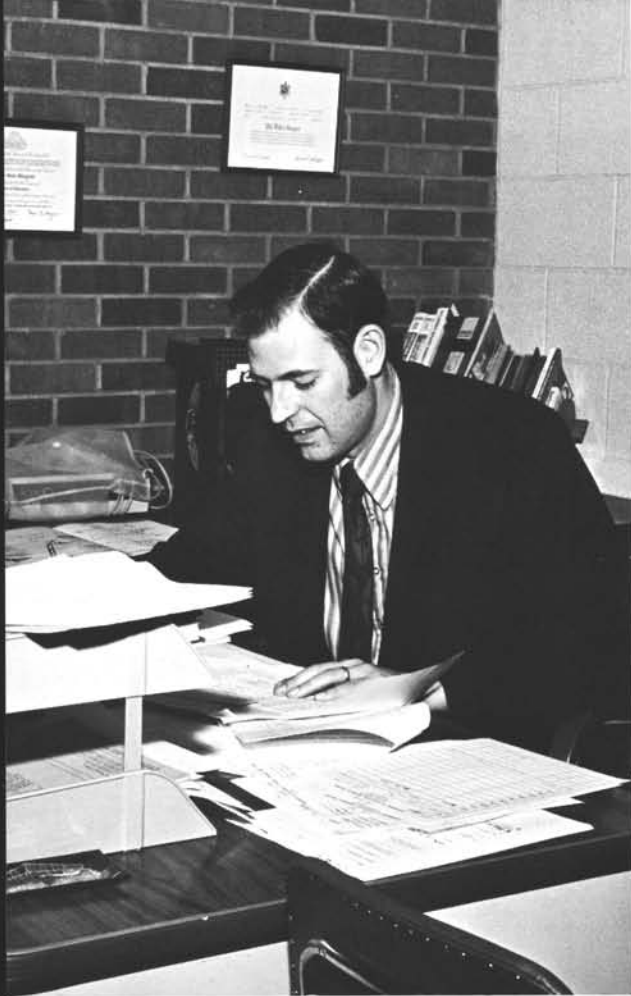


Career With Prospects? It's in Agriculture
