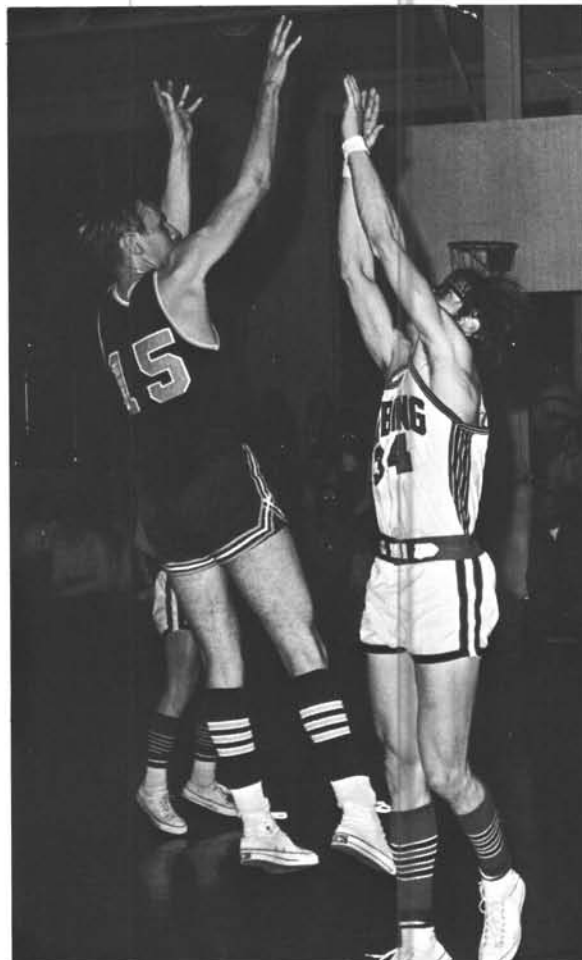


Men on Way Up

The Trojan cagers finished their season with a 9-11 record overall. As defending champions of the northwest division, they faced the frustration of a third-place and an 8-2 tally. Leading scorer and rebounder was Pablo Ronderos, who averaged 21.2 points per game, had a game average of 11 rebounds, gained a berth on the All-MJCAA team and was named Most Valuable Player by his teammates. In summing up the season, Coach Marv Bachmeier declared: "Although we did not win the conference, we did make a great deal of improvement. We have a good nucleus returning next fall, and we hope to be champions again."
