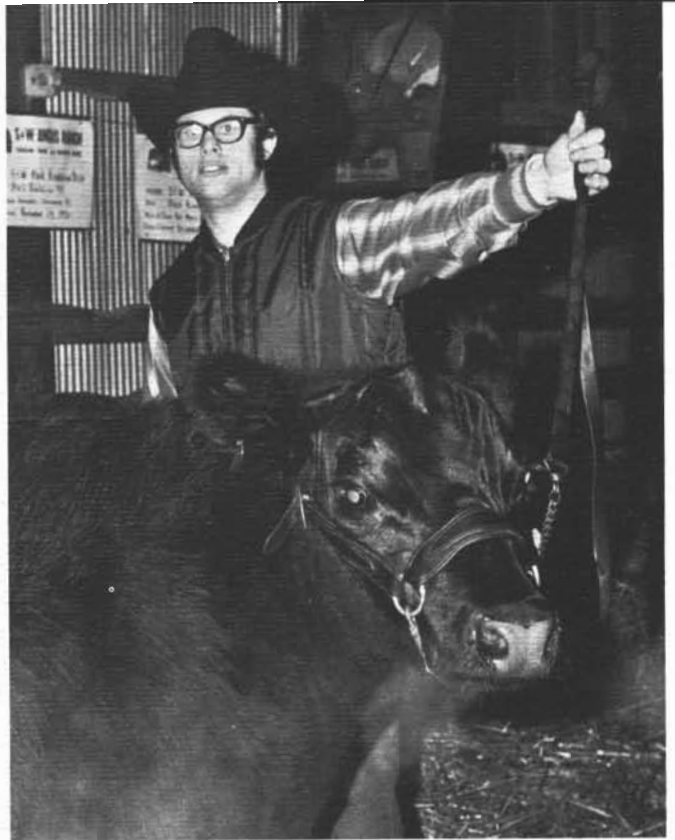
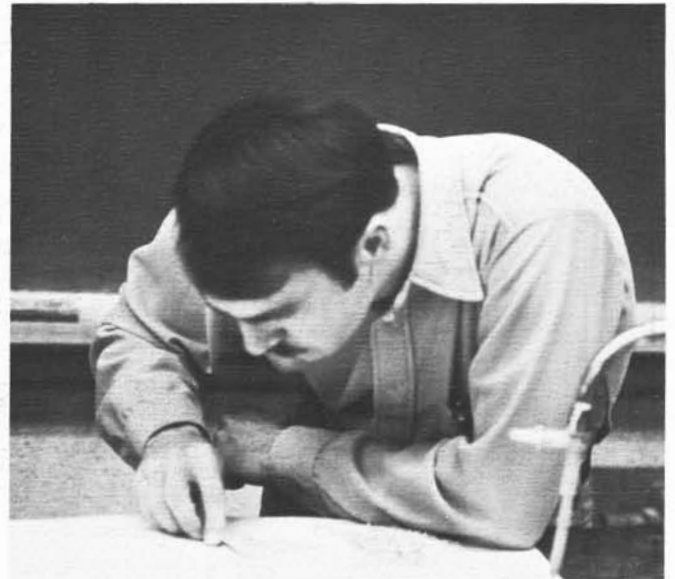
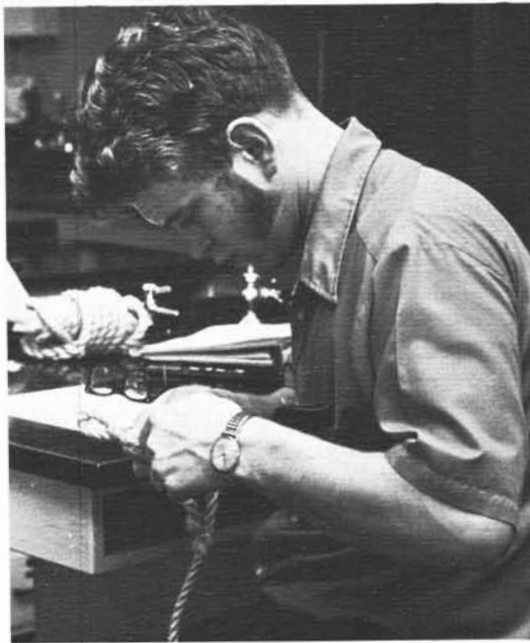


Nothing's Static in Ag Division
