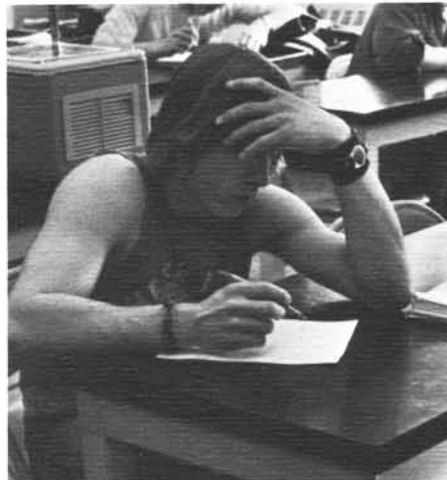


# General Education Offers Academic Training
